1. Arizona Online; Global Campus; Global Direct Campus; Main Campus
 - a. Finding the right campus for each student
 - b. Each campus has a unique price structure – pot shape/size
 - c. There is a unique list of degrees, including majors and minors – soil variety
 - d. A different way to support student success – type of flowers that thrive
 - e. Not all programs are available in the online campus
2. Arizona Online
 - a. Limited merit aid available
 - b. Eligible for financial aid
 - c. Honors College programming not available
 - d. ROTC not available
 - e. Undergrad and grad degrees available
 - f. Launching new programs
 - i. Proposals can be submitted twice per year
 1. Summer and March deadlines depending on first term of program

- 5. Fall 2021 Plan
 - a. Plan to return most courses on Main Campus to fully-in person formats
 - b. All in-person courses will adhere to CDC guidelines
 - c. Students planning to learn completely remotely/online should enroll in Live Online or iCourses
 - d. Format of class will not be changed once students are enrolled
 - i. Format changes will need a new section to be added
- 6. Questions
 - a. Where in the Student Center will students see their enrollment appointment date?
 - i. Main page when they login
 - b. Will the degree audit worksheet ever go online?
 - i. Project underway to review how degrees are conferred
 - ii. Planning to envision what this looks like with the advising community over the next year
 - iii. Planning to create more efficient and timely process for degree conferral
 - iv. Goal is to have most degrees conferred within two days of the end of the semester
 - c. Is there a chance the undergrad cert applications move online too?
 - d. Are centrally scheduled classrooms returning to pre-pandemic capacities for fall?
 - i. Using guidance from public health advisors
 - e. What are classroom capacities for fall?
 - i. Plan for fall is to return basically to pre-pandemic levels
 - ii. Evaluation to review crowded classrooms and plan to provide more should room
 - f. Any idea on how we're going to plan for spacing in classroom with social distancing with classrooms?
